The Interlake School Division (ISD) supports volunteerism within the community. To acknowledge the efforts of those students who make a contribution by volunteering for worthwhile causes or organizations outside the school system, a Community Service Credit may be granted under the guidelines of a [Student Initiated Project \(SIP\)](#). Upon satisfying the requirements, as agreed upon with the Principal of the school, a student will receive a Community Service Credit for 55 hours (0.5 credit) and 110 hours (1 credit) to a maximum of one credit for certified volunteer activities.

Activities, which normally take place within the school such as coaching a school team, student council, TADD, etc. do not qualify as activities in support of this credit.
